Senior Safety and Awareness

Make your home a safe place to live:

- 1) Install quality locks on your doors and windows.
- 2) Do not hide spare keys outside of your home.
- 3) Leave a spare key with a trusted neighbor.
- 4) Request identification from Service Workers & Delivery People before allowing them into your home. If in doubt, call the company to confirm purpose and identity.
- 5) Make sure your address is clear and large enough for emergency personal to see it from the street.
- 6) Consider a home monitoring system for burglary, fire and medical emergencies.

- 7) If something makes you uncomfortable, trust your instincts.

Watch out for con artists:

- 1) Don't fall for anything that sounds too good to be true.
- 2) Free prizes, vacations, and medical cures are usually schemes to take your money.
- 3) Never give your credit card, social security, or bank account numbers to anyone over the telephone.
- 4) Remember, it is illegal for telemarketers to ask you for any personal and financial numbers to verify a legitimate gift or prize.
- 5) Do not allow anyone to rush you into signing any legal or binding contracts, insurance policies, or sales agreements.
- 6) Read all documents carefully and ask someone you trust to look over the documents.
- 7) Beware of individuals claiming to help you recover lost money for a fee.
- 8) If you are suspicious, check with the Better Business Bureau, or National League of Fraud at 1-800-876-7060, and call your local Police Department.

Watch out for Identity Theft:

- 1) Do not give out personal information over the phone, mail, or internet, unless you have initiated the communication, or definitely know who you are dealing with.
- 2) Shred all discarded documents that contain personal or financial information.
- 3) Do not use your mother's middle name, your date of birth, or last four digits of your social security number when creating secret passwords.
- 4) Never carry your social security card, personal identification, and passport together, unless it is absolutely necessary.
- 5) Do not carry credit cards you do not need.
