Bored Internet Kids

Idle hands may be the Devils Workshop, but busy hands can get kids in plenty of mischief. During long unsupervised summer days when kids sit in front of the computer, the risks of internet bullying and sexual predators are at its highest. Kids who normally wouldn't dream of posting a provocative photo on their My-Space page or joining in "online hazing" may be tempted to do so out of boredom. Sometimes they take risks without realizing it by posting their cell phone numbers, camp location, and dates they'll be away to alert their friends – and everyone else. Working parents may want to install filtering devices or monitoring software such as Spector Pro, which restricts sites kids can visit and tracks what they do on line.
